* We propose an abstract metal sculpture inspired by two strands of DNA, connecting the Medical Centre with the community and also the past, present and future.



*Metal structure is to be made from recycled metal with high gloss chrome finish in line with the concept of integrating the old and new.

* High gloss chrome surfaces are intended to reflect the light, addressing the visibility requirement from both sides.

* Polished surfaces have the practical element of being durable, strong and easy to clean.



* An intertwining thread of colour will run through the structure, bringing a positive and uplifting aspect to the organic composition.

* Budget is to be used to outsource skilled labour, material purchase, collection, chroming process and transport.
